

SAMARITAN HOMELESS INTERIM PROGRAM (SHIP)

Since 2008, PNANJ Somerset has been supporting the Samaritan Homeless Interim Program (SHIP). We have assisted them with their soup kitchen, food distribution, operations and Adopt a Family by giving gifts during the holiday. In 2022, we have donated \$200 its 33rd annual Holiday Meal.

SHIP, the Samaritan Homeless Interim Program, began operations on March 5, 1984 in response to the unheeded cry of the many women, children and men who are in desperate need of emergency housing and associated services.

SHIP is a faith based, interfaith and community funded, assisted and supported, grassroots organization.

Clients coming to SHIP are in desperate need of help. Many are the working poor. They include those that suffer from homelessness or being near homeless. Many are hungry or suffer from substance abuse dependency, HIV/AIDS, mental health issues, or neglect and isolation.


Services are tailored to each individual's need and vary in duration according to each individual or family's situation. SHIP provides this unique population with critically needed emergency interim services. These services may include advocacy, emergency interim housing, interim counseling, and support services, that greatly enhance their chances of regaining their self-sufficiency again. SHIP is dedicated to improving the quality of life for the poor. Clients are eligible to apply for all of SHIP's Programs and Services.

At SHIP we create programs and services that increase the Somerset County and surrounding regions capacity to respond to the needs of the poor and working poor.

The Foodbank Network of Somerset County



Incorporated in 1982, the Food Bank Network of Somerset County, Inc. is a non-governmental, non-sectarian, 501(c)3 not-for-profit public benefit organization. For the past 40 years The Food Bank has been responding to the needs of the food insecure in Somerset County, New Jersey.

THE FOOD BANK Network of Somerset County's MISSION

The mission of The Food Bank Network is to distribute food and provide other basic human needs to those less fortunate in our community in a manner recognizing and advancing self-worth and human dignity. Working through our warehouse-pantry in Bridgewater and satellite food pantries, our goal is to help feed and provision people in need until they become self-sufficient.

We aid any Somerset County residents requesting help who either find us directly or are referred by public and private county agencies. To do this, we have professional staff members, an unpaid board of directors, and countless volunteers across the county who give their time and donations to help us continue our work.

The Food Bank Network is a non-governmental, non-sectarian, 501(c)(3) not-for-profit public benefit organization.

PNANJ Somerset Megan Chan's Project for Leadership Somerset was to assist the Food bank in order to mitigate food insecurity in Somerset County. PNANJ Somerset focuses on social determinants of health and food is one of the basic needs that is essential to living. We pledged to donate \$200 annually to the food bank.

INDIAN HEALTH CAMP OF NEW JERSEY (IHCNJ)



Indian Health Camp of New Jersey (IHCNJ), a non-profit IRS 501(c) (3) organization, was established in 1998 to provide health screening for early detection and disease prevention of medical abnormalities including but not limited to chronic diseases such as diabetes, hypertension, heart disease and various types of cancer. At this health fair,

PNANJ Somerset volunteered at Princeton and at Secaucus where they assisted with blood pressure screening and EKG for vulnerable people over age 40 without medical insurance. A total of over 200 people were serviced with complimentary health screenings.



Philippine American Friendship Community, Inc. (PAFCOM)Parade and Health Screening

PNANJ had a collaborative health screening at the PAFCOM Parade on June 26, 2022. It was a celebration of our unique and vibrant Filipino Heritage. 

We also celebrated the birthdays of the "Summer Babies" – people who have birthdays on May, June, July, and August.








